Booth registration includes breaks and lunches for two registered representatives. Additional representatives may register at \$50 each.



#### **Hotel Accommodations**

There are several hotels near University of Utah Campus, but the University Guest House, at 110 Fort Douglas Blvd, Salt Lake City, UT 84113, is the most conveniently located.


